We are writing in response to your email received by Post Office Limited ("Post Office") on 11 November, which has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("FOIA").

In your email you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

Good morning, with regard to the area usually covered by the Buxton, Derbyshire sorting office. How many times was mail not delivered because the recipients' properties were 'inaccessible' in the 2 months prior to the closure of this sorting office? How many times was mail not delivered because the recipients' properties were 'inaccessible' since the closure of this sorting office?

We can confirm we do not hold the information you have requested. Post Office separated from Royal Mail Group ("Royal Mail") on 01 April 2012; therefore, we do not have access to information held by Royal Mail, including the requested information.
