Freedom of Information Request – FOI2024/01199

We are writing in response to your email received by Post Office Limited (“**Post Office**”) on 25 August, which has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“**FOIA**”).

In your email you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

“I am writing to request information regarding who pays for the numerous hanging baskets and planters adorning the Post Office in [Redacted], ([Redacted]). If the Post Office does not pay for these who does? If the Post Office contributes - then how much?”

We can confirm that Post Office does not hold the information you have requested. The Post Office in [Redacted], ([Redacted]) is a privately run franchised branch, such expenditure would be dealt with independently.
