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

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



The BBC contacted our Press Office yesterday, Wednesday 20th March 2024 on behalf of two members of the public raising their experiences and concerns.

I have attached a copy of the email we received, advising that Post Office is likely to feature on an upcoming episode of BBC Watchdog on The One Show, which broadcasts on Wednesday evenings on BBC One across the UK from 7pm.

The deadline for any response is 5pm on Tuesday 26th March 2024.

Each had purchased stamps from two different Post Office branches, later deemed to be counterfeit by Royal Mail. Neither of these customers has raised their concerns with us directly. And neither of the branches has raised any concerns with their Post Office Business Support Centre.

Evidence and our permission to share the customers details and experiences was requested, and received today as per the attachments.

In view of the potential collateral damage to the reputations of both Post Office and Royal Mail please may we ask that urgent investigations are undertaken.

A Post Office spokesperson said:

"We're saddened that criminals are seeking to profiteer from counterfeit stamps and we, like many others, want to see them removed from circulation as fast as possible. Stamps can be purchased from a wide variety of shops and online. Allegations that fake stamps have been purchased from a Post Office are extremely serious and could undermine our Postmasters and their business which is why we always ask that an itemised receipt along with a high-quality image of the stamp or stamps is sent to us so that this can be looked into further. At that point we will make enquiries, liaising with our Postmaster and Royal Mail, in order to do our best to resolve the issue for our customers."
