Freedom of Information Request – FOI2025/00608

We are writing in response to your email received by Post Office Limited (**“Post Office”**) on 21 August 2025, which has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (**“FOIA”**).

In your email, you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

“Have you checked when Horizon was switched off at Speenhamland Post Office?”

We can confirm that Post Office does hold some information relevant to your request.

As disclosed in our previous response (FOI2025/00514), whilst there is no definitive record confirming the formal closure of the branch, records indicate that no Postmaster has operated at this location since February 2005.

Horizon was last recorded as being used in January 2010, with no activity documented between February 2005 and then.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of this response, you do have a right to request an internal review.
