Our people reflect the diversity of the communities in which we live and work, and the customers we serve. The things which make us different are accepted, valued, and celebrated.


Pride Month

Our Supplier Code of Conduct states our expectation that suppliers should practice diversity and equality agenda in line with the Post Office values - with no discrimination on race, religion and belief, disability, gender reassignment, sexual orientation, age, pregnancy/maternity or marriage and civil partnership.

Your organisation can ensure this through the policies and working practices in your company by including wording to make your commitment clear. You can also review your recruitment, staff mentoring and development processes to reflect these aims.

You can provide networks and resource hubs for colleagues to read about diversity and inclusion, listen to the experiences of others, and to find tools to learn more about this area.
