Freedom of Information Request – FOI2024/00782

We are writing in response to your email received by Post Office Limited (“**Post Office**”) on 14 May, which has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“**FOIA**”). We apologise for the delay in answering your request.

In your email you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

“Please can you disclose all email correspondence between PO Chair, Alice Perkins, and Royal Mail CE, Moya Green, between June 2013-October 2013 inclusive. Please include any briefings for meetings or calls between Perkins and Green within this period.

Please can you also disclose all email correspondence of PO Chair, Alice Perkins, and Royal Mail Chair, Donald Brydon, between June 2013-October 2013 inclusive. Please include briefings for meetings or calls between Perkins and Brydon within this period.”

We can confirm that Post Office does hold some of the information you have requested.

We carried out an electronic search for correspondence between Alice Perkins and Moya Green between June 2013 and October 2013, which returned no results.

We also carried out an electronic search for correspondence between Alice Perkins and Donald Brydon between June 2013 and October 2013, which returned 20 results. Upon manual review of the results, we found one email sent from Donald Brydon to Alice Perkins in September 2013 and the remainder were not correspondence between the two requested individuals and are therefore not within the scope of your request. Please see the attached document titled "FOIA Response_FOI2024_00782_Correspondence_Redacted.pdf" which contains the information within scope of your request. Redactions have been made under sections 40(2) and 40(3A) of the FOIA as the information constitutes personal data relating to other persons. These sections exempt personal information from disclosure if that information relates to someone other than the applicant, and if disclosure of that information would breach any of the data protection principles in Article 5(1) of the UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Please also see attached document titled "FOIA Response_FOI2024_00782_RMH Directors Appointment Letter_Redacted" which was included as an attachment within the email in scope of your request.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of this response, you do have a right to request an internal review. You can do this by writing to the address above within 40 working days of receipt of this response stating your reasons for your internal review request or alternatively, by emailing information.rights@postoffice.co.uk.
