We are writing in response to your email received by Post Office Limited ("**Post Office**") on 12 April, which has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("**FOIA**").

In your email you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

"I am writing to make a request under the Freedom of Information act 2000. I am requesting the following information:

* A list of animal attacks on Postmen/Postwomen in Powys over the last year.

* Whether any of the postmen/women involved suffered injuries .

* Could this be broken down by incident with details of the incident and the animal involved.

If you are encountering practical difficulties with complying with this request, please contact me as soon as possible (in line with your duty under Section 16 of the FOI Act to advise and assist requesters), so that we can discuss the matter and if necessary I can modify the request."

We can confirm that Post Office does not hold the information you have requested. Please note, Post Office separated from Royal Mail Group ("**Royal Mail**") on 1 April 2012, and we therefore do not have access to information held by Royal Mail, including the requested information.
