We are writing in response to your email received by Post Office Limited (“**Post Office**”) on 9 August, which has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“**FOIA**”).

In your email you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

“You say that you do not have service level agreements within the contracts you operate. In the circumstances, could you please provide me with the name of any document that covers your agreement with A.F. Blakemore.”

Please note that I have been in contact with your External Affairs Team concerning the quality of service the Post Office in [REDACTED] is providing to our local residents.”

We can confirm that Post Office does hold the information you have requested.

Post Office has a “Strategic Partner Framework Agreement”, which is a commercial agreement that covers all of A.F. Blakemore’s branches.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of this response, you do have a right to request an internal review.
